WHAT IS TRASH REMOVAL?

Bulk trash can include waste items that are typically too large to be disposed of in your regular curbside trash container. In addition, the trash may not necessarily consist of large items, but may simply be in quantities too large to make use of your residential trash bins.

If you're a typical household, you may make it a practice to do some major cleaning a few times a year. We're all familiar with "spring cleaning," but many people also take advantage of the last bit of good fall weather to do some major cleaning before winter sets in.

Regardless of when or how often, these <u>large cleaning projects</u> can often result in large piles of trash made up of both big and small items. And these have to be removed and disposed of. This is when professional trash removal comes in handy!



Most towns and cities have some type of municipal waste management and this often includes having large trash bins for homes. These are usually emptied on a weekly basis in most areas although the schedule and level of service might vary in rural areas.

Private contractors often take on the actual trash pick up and hauling, while most larger cities have their own municipal agencies managing trash removal services. The typical suburban home in most locations will have some combination of a black or gray trash bin, a blue "recycling" bin, and often a green organic waste bin. For those residents who've never experienced life without these bins, it can be an odd thing to imagine having just one or two metal trash cans with lids that may or may not fit!

If you've ever wondered how much trash needs to be removed in the United States?

According to the **Environment Protection Agency**, or EPA,






EPA refers to trash, or municipal solid waste (MSW), as various items consumers throw away after they are used. These items include bottles and corrugated boxes, food, grass clippings, sofas, computers, tires and refrigerators. However, MSW does not include everything that is landfilled in MSW, or nonhazardous, landfills, such as construction and demolition (C&D) debris, municipal wastewater sludge, and other non-hazardous industrial wastes."

And how much of this "MSW" do we generate every year? The EPA estimates that the total generation of municipal solid waste in 2017 was 267.8 million tons, or 4.51 pounds per person per day.

The following chart illustrates the typical breakdown of what we throw out in our trash:

When it comes to getting rid of your large or bulky trash items, you do have a few options. The most obvious one, perhaps, is to simply do it yourself. The problem with this approach is that most people own cars, but not nearly as many have a truck. And, while you might be able to stuff all that trash in your trunk, it's not likely nor is it very practical.

This then means having to get access to a truck or even a flatbed trailer to remove and haul away your bulk trash.

If you know someone with a truck who's willing to either loan it to you or drive for you, then this might be a good way to go. Another option is to rent a truck. But this will involve not only paying for the fuel, but truck rental and insurance, as well. And either option still requires that you do all the work - lifting, loading and securing the loads - and then having to unload it at the landfill or other waste management facility.

Then there are the inevitable fees that have to be paid at the landfill. These can include the dumping, or tipping, fee along with fees associated with various types of items such as appliances with
Freon, electronics and other materials.



The other approach to trash removal is to hire someone else to do it for you. While you can certainly find individuals in most areas of the country who hire themselves out to do trash or junk hauling, this is not always the most efficient or cost effective option. Most paper materials, clean cardboard, electronics, small and large appliances, glass items, most plastics, and pretty much any kind of metal can be recycled.

Even organic materials such as wood and yard waste can be repurposed and reused. The good news is that many household items that end up in the trash are made primarily of either plastic or metal, and both plastics and metals are highly recyclable and recoverable. By choosing to use an eco-friendly company like Junk King you will know that as much of the reusable material that can be recovered and recycled.

It's important to keep in mind that some trash items such as electronics or refrigerated appliances contain hazardous materials. With most electronics, they can contain toxic metals such as lead, mercury, cadmium and toxic chemicals. Every state regulates how these are handled and classify them as household hazardous waste.

Most refrigerators, especially those built before 1995, contain Freon or other similar chemicals. These are solvents that must be handled carefully and are harmful to the environment. In addition, Freon in an old appliance must be collected by a recycling center before the appliance itself can be recycled.



If you choose to take your own trash and remove it to a dumping facility, in addition to your fuel and possibly truck rental costs, you will have to pay tipping fees when you dispose of your trash at the site.

Wikipedia states that a tipping fee,





[I]is the charge levied upon a given quantity of waste received at a waste processing facility. In the case of a landfill it is generally levied to offset the cost of opening, maintaining and eventually closing the site."

And these fees have been increasing every year.

According to one article,



According to data compiled through Waste Business Journal's <u>direct</u> <u>survey</u> of landfill managers, the national average cost per ton of landfilled waste in 2017 was \$50.30 per ton, which is forecast to rise to \$51.19 by the end of 2018 and projected to climb even higher through 2021.

Nationally, the MSW tipping fee, which includes both landfill and incineration disposal, is projected to rise another 6 percent to \$53.53 per ton by 2021."


